- 1. Candidates with an evaluation from the OPTM ould make an application to the Program by the March 1 deadline through the regular College application process.
 - a. OPTMQ evaluation will be used assess which courses are required.

 - c. The candidate will be interviewed. Language testing may be required.
 - d. Candidates who miss the March deadline will be assessed if the sespace in August.
- 2. Documents required (in addition to the documents required by the College for admission)
 - a. OPTMQ evaluation
 - b. Transcript of clinicæducationand most recent education
 - c. Letter of intent
 - d. Work experience
- 3. Language equirements
 - a. English language requirement: Candidates must be able to function in English (oral, reading and writing skills) at the College level.
 - b. French language requirement: Candidates must demonstrate sufficientch language skills before entering the Programin order to function in the clinical workplace during the stage component
 - c. Candidates may be required to take an English and/or French language placement test.
- 4. Admission on the basis of the OPTMQ evaluation
 - a. Two yearprofile: If the courses required tattain the missing competencies can be offered within a two year period, admission will be contingent the availability of clinical spaces and DEC enrolment in second year.
 - b. Three yeaprofile: If the courses required to attaithe missing competencies must be spread over three years, the candidatesnay beoffered admission to register only for the program specific (concentration) courses.

- x Spaceis limited by the number of clinical spaces available. DEC students will have priority over the clinical spaces. Decisions will be made only after clinical space considerations have been determined for DEC students.
- x Candidates will registernly for the courses that are required by the OPTMQtfreeir license to practicei.e., candidates will not receive a DEC).
- x Candidates must pass ALL couisses hich they are registereto advance in the Program The Program Standing and Advancement policies be applied, in the case of any failures.
